UB is located in the heart of Fairfield County, **an hour and a half from New York City** and **two hours from Boston**. The campus sits on a stretch of **Long Island Sound** and is **adjacent to the beautiful Seaside Park**. Just a short ferry ride to Long Island, a five-minute shuttle ride to the Metro North train station and bus terminal, and at the base of Connecticut's Routes 8 and 25 and Interstate 95, UB is perfectly situated for easy access to local and tri-state area hot spots, dining, and entertainment.

- Ferry boat services

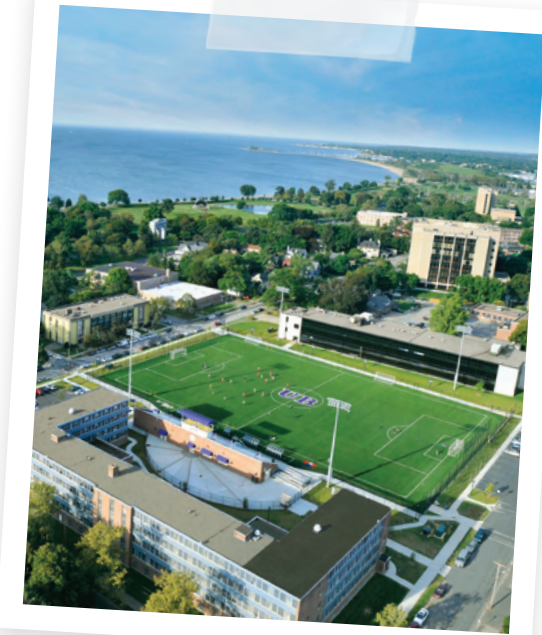
Campus Safety

Your safety is of utmost importance. The University has received the prestigious Jeanne Clery Campus Safety Award for adopting technology and other initiatives to safeguard our students 24 hours a day.

LiveSafe is the official UB security and information app for students, faculty, and staff, available for Android and iPhone devices. LiveSafe allows users to send messages to Campus Security, share locations with friends or family, locate buildings on campus, and access emergency services and preparedness information. LiveSafe also allows University of Bridgeport to transmit messages to users, informing them of an event that may have a direct impact on health or safety.

The Campus Security Department is also responsible for providing the following support services:

- Issuing ID access cards to students, faculty, and staff to ensure safe and secure entrance to all buildings on campus
- Providing personal safety (walking) escorts on campus
- Maintaining a lost and found department
- Assisting on-campus motorists with vehicle jump starts and vehicle unlocks
- Providing the University community with crime prevention information

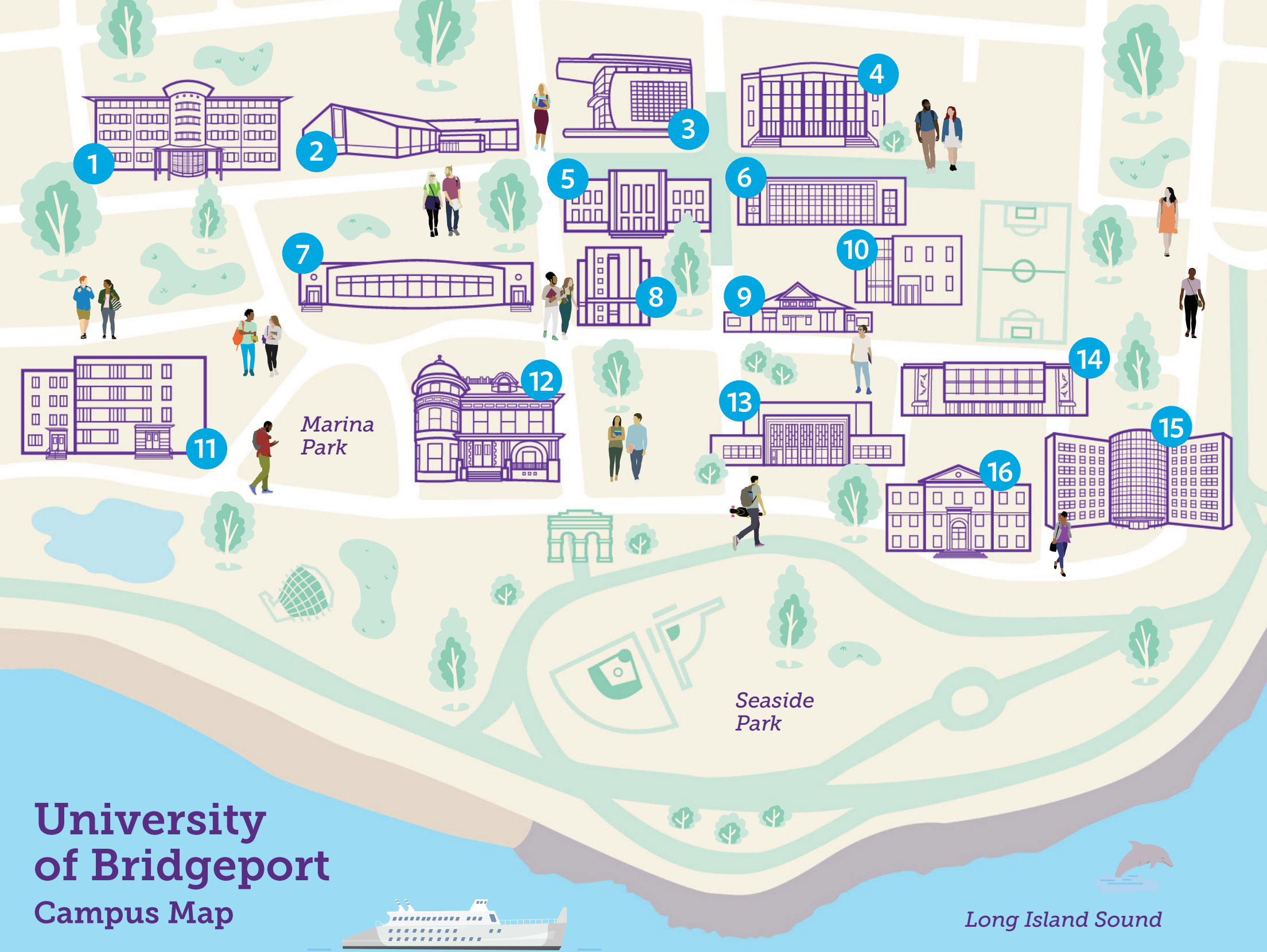

1 University Hall

This facility offers two styles of housing: traditional style double rooms and suites with apartment-style housing.

2 Wheeler Recreation Center

The recreation center offers a variety of athletic programming including six intramural sports and wellness programs.

3 Mandeville Hall – School of Business

The Ernest C. Trefz School of Business provides students with a holistic view of business theory and practice.

4 John J. Cox Student Center

5 Carlson Hall

8 Wahlstrom Library

9 Campus Security

Security is staffed by 40 personnel and a dispatcher.

This hall is home to UB's human cadaver lab for graduate-level dissections and undergraduate natural science classes.

11 Seeley Hall

This traditional co-ed style residence hall offers standard double rooms and a view of the Long Island Sound and Seaside Park.

12 Bauer Hall Innovation Center

The hall is a new center for student-entrepreneurs for the growth of new and current businesses.

13 Harvey Hubbell Gymnasium

The gym is home to UB's basketball teams, women's volleyball team, and the main athletic offices and training room.

14 School of Chiropractic
